

Medical requirements memo for CEV major competitions

This memo summarises the medical requirements, which are part of the agreement signed by the Organiser and the CEV.

More detailed information can be found in the FIVB Medical Regulations (<u>www.fivb.org</u>), WADA regulations (<u>www.wada-ama.org</u>) and CEV regulations (<u>www.cev.eu</u>).

First aid:

- The organiser must make all arrangements for the players, team delegations, officials and spectators first aid (during competition and training) and provide a reasonable number of medical doctors and nurses, first aid room, stretchers, etc.
- The closest hospital has to be informed of the event enough time in advance.
- An ambulance is highly recommended in front of hall or available on call within 10 minutes.
- First aid personnel should stay all time the on the determined place next the court with medical equipment and stretcher, to provide first aid during training and competition.

Personnel:

Minimum of one medical doctor (for first aid, doping testing procedure, medical check of referees) who has to be officially accredited by the organiser and be present at the competition venue during the entire duration of the event. His/her contacts must be provided to the CEV medical delegate and the CEV medical officer – medical@cev.eu – at least 1 month prior the event.

Minimum of four chaperones for doping testing procedure dully accredited and identified (shirt or badge).

Rooms:

- Doping testing area (see Medical regulations) with path dully signalised
- Waiting room 25 m², seats (minimum 6)
- Sampling room table, seats (minimum 4)
- Toilet
- Fridge with closed bottles, no caffeine drinks
- First aid room with stretcher
- Room for medical check of referees

Material:

- Fridge for ice for the players near the court
- Breath alcohol analysis equipment
- Calibrated weight scale and height rod
- Snellen chart
- Blood pressure monitor
- 2 bags with chips for drawing lettered from A to N (two sets with different colours)
- Wi-Fi internet connection for the CEV Medical Delegate
